# **ADVICE to prevent Robberies/thefts**

**Guarda Nacional Republicana**  
*WELCOMING, CLOSE AND TRUSTWORTHY*



- At home, keep the doors and windows closed, reinforce lighting around the house and, if possible, install fences and railing.
- If you are alone in the house, do not let anyone perceive that; pretend you're with family or friends and call their name.
- Always have with you phone numbers which you can use to communicate with someone, especially the local police or 112 (for emergencies).
- If you have to leave the house for several days, inform your neighbours and local GNR.
- Do not leave notes on the door, window or postbox which indicate your absence.
- When someone knocks on the door, do not open straight away; first, make sure you know who's knocking.
- If you hear a firearm or suspicious noises outside, inform the local GNR or call 112 immediately; do not go out to see what is going on.
- If someone asks you for something or for money for some institution, verify its name and the credentials of the person.
- Try to know all your neighbours and cooperate with them in all aspects of security.
- In case you feel observed by a stranger, you should immediately inform the local GNR.
